(1982, Madrid)

Lives and works in Madrid.



She holds a degree in Fine Arts in Castilla-La Mancha in Spain and her long stays influenced her artistic practice, developing interests in non-occidental traditional techniques. Her study of shapes and colors is revealed as fluid profiles. In her painting, indeed, Elvira Amor searches for a pre-verbal language, approaching traditional themes of abstract painting.

"In my practice I work with color and form, I think of painting as that mental image that is constructed from what is visible, the environment around, the floor, objects, walls. I am interested in the atmosphere that a group of pieces gives off, and how they impact people and space."

# MARCO EMMANUELE

(1986, Catania) Lives and works in Rome.

In his research, the relationship with technology and the ability of man to deeply transform the environment in which he lives is always firm. He deals with industrial materials such as steel, ceramics and glass, transmuting their nature in the artistic language and examining them in their expressive potentialities.

In his last research he experimented the pictoriality of pigments obtained by mixing glue and glass dust. The latter element is chosen by Emmanuele between the debris gathered on the beach, differentiated by color and milled until it is ready to be spread upon the canvas or by using the technique of glass fusing, thus creating a dialogue between the charcoal drawing on paper and the hardness of the glass material.


The artist juxtaposes pastel chromatisms building the images in flat and materic fields, with a result that shows bold visive assonances with the techniques of the fresco and the mosaic.



# GIULIA MARCHI

(1976, Rimini) Lives and works in Rimini.

Her artistic background, characterized by a strong literary imprint, has led her to an expressiveness often associated with narrativity. Fundamental is the result of an in-depth study of the writings of contemporary Dutch architect Rem Koolhaas. borrowing its title from the 14th Venice Architecture Biennale, which he curated. The work stems from a desire to connect artistic research with Koolhaas' ideas. Inspired by Junkspace, an essay merging vision and pragmatism, it explores space and its use through photographs of discarded objects wooden rods, cardboard, wrapping paper, and construction debris. It contrasts the purity of emptiness with the structured aesthetics of Russian Suprematism. Shot inside the unfinished New Wing of the Museum of the City of Rimini, which has remained in a state of suspension for years, the images were captured with a bioptic analog camera, without special printing interventions.

Some of her artworks are part of these collections: MAXXI in Roma, CAMUSAC in Cassino, MAMbo in Bologna, Collezione Maramotti in Reggio Emilia, Collezione MiramART in Santa Margherita Ligure and other important private, national and international collections.








